

Capping Manual

Capping will add 1" to the diameter of the tub and 7/8" to the height. Rim decks must be be placed below the capping and cannot be mounted flush.

1. Make sure the top lip is dry and level.
2. Dry fit the caps to check the fit. If the cap is too large, cut off excess.
3. Using 100% silicone caulking, apply a generous bead to the top lip of the tub and squeeze down the cap.
4. Allow silicone to dry for at least 24 hours before refilling the tub.
